

Payment Terms & Price List

The following outlines how fees are calculated, billed, and paid for all services provided by **Kintail Equine (the Trainer)**. By submitting an enquiry form or placing a horse into our care, the Owner acknowledges that they have read and understood these terms.

1. Payment Approach

- Invoices are issued based on services provided and in line with the **current price list** below.
- Payment is due **on or before the 20th of the month following the invoice date**, unless an alternative arrangement is agreed in writing.
- All outstanding charges must be settled **before horses are uplifted** from the property.
- Charges are calculated from the date the horse arrives until the date it leaves Kintail Equine's care.
- In the event of early termination, charges will be calculated up to the termination date, and any balance due must be paid before collection.
- Additional costs, such as veterinary services, supplementary feed, extra services or special services required or requested, will be added to the invoice.

2. Payment Options

We offer flexibility to accommodate your preferences:

- **Monthly Invoice:** Work completed is invoiced at the end of each month. Payment is due on the 20th of the following month.
- **Instalments:** A weekly or agreed payment schedule may be arranged. All instalments must be fully paid before your horse is uplifted.

- **Upfront Payment:** Total fees can be invoiced at the start of training. Any overpayment due to early termination will be reimbursed.

All payment arrangements are subject to prior agreement. Please discuss your preferred option before training commences.

3. Current Price List

All amounts below are shown **exclusive of GST** and **inclusive of GST (15%)** and are valid for bookings made after 01 January 2026 and before 31 December 2026.

The price advertised at the time of booking is the price charged. Any subsequent price increases will not apply to existing bookings
